



ORDER
(March ~~30~~ 2011) [#13]

For the reasons set forth above, it is this ___ day of March, 2011 hereby ORDERED that defendants' Motion to Dismiss [Dkt. #13] is GRANTED, and it is further

ORDERED that the above-captioned case be DISMISSED with prejudice on all counts which fail to state a claim (Counts I, II, III; Counts VI and VII (to the extent they seek rulings on classifications of specific games before approving the Lytton gaming ordinance); and Counts VI, VII, and VIII (to the extent they seek enforcement of discretionary NIGC decisions which are not subject to judicial review)), and DISMISSED without prejudice on all remaining counts over which this Court has no subject-matter jurisdiction (all or parts of Counts III, IV, V, VI, VII, and VIII).
