

The following schedule of fines has been adopted by the Senate. The schedule applies to the civil traffic infractions enumerated in the Swinomish Civil Traffic Code. If a “yes” appears under “mandatory appearance,” the person must appear before the Court for a hearing and cannot pay the fine in lieu of that Court appearance.

A copy of the schedule shall be posted and available for public inspection at the Office of the Clerk of the Court and the Swinomish Police Station.
