### **CHAPTER 4 - RECREATION PERMITS**

## **ARTICLE 1 - NONMEMBER HUNTING PERMITS (SUSPENDED)**

Legislative History: Ordinance No. 32, governing the issuance of hunting permits to nonmembers, was enacted by the Papago Council on April 4, 1958 and approved by the Papago Agency Superintendent on April 11, 1958; Ordinance No. 32 suspended by Resolution No. 15-148, "Suspending 19 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4, Article 1 - Nonmember Hunting Permits and Establishing Moratorium on Hunting by Nonmembers" effective May 15, 2015. Resolution No. 15-148 will sunset May 17, 2017.

3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that a non-member
4	hunting or attempting to hunt on the Tohono O'odham Nation shall be subject to
5	(1) a civil fine of up to \$10,000 per violation;
6	(2) civil forfeiture of weapons, communications technology, vehicles or
7	other property in accordance with the procedure set forth in 7 T.O.C.
8	Chapter 1, Section 1.17; and
9	(3) remove and exclusion in accordance with 4 T.O.C. Chapter 2 – Removal
10	and Exclusion of Non-Members.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that nothing in this
12	resolution prevents an enrolled Nation's member from hunting within the
13	exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation, provided that:
14	a person subject to the Nation's criminal jurisdiction may be prosecuted for
15	Criminal Damage to Public Property, Conspiracy, Solicitation, Aiding and
16	Abetting, Unlawful Assembly, or other offenses for assisting, accompanying, or
17	guiding a non-member hunting or for otherwise violating the Nation's laws and
18	shall be subject to forfeiture of weapons, communications technology, vehicles,
19	or other property used in the commission of such an offense in accordance with
20	the procedure set forth in 7 T.O.C. Chapter 1, Section 1.17.
21	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the provisions of this resolution to suspend Ordinance No. 32
22	and establish a moratorium on hunting by nonmembers shall expire on May 17,
23	2017, at which time Ordinance No. 32 shall again be in effect and the
24	moratorium on non-member hunting shall be lifted.
